RULES & REGULATIONS

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT. By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Chagrin Hunter Jumper Classic at Chagrin Valley Farms (competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors, and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

USEF/USHJA CREDENTIALS AND MEASUREMENT CARDS. All participants must present to the show secretary current USEF and USHJA membership cards or copies thereof. Amateur certification, and measurement cards for Junior Hunters and Pony Hunters must be presented to the horse show secretary before numbers will be issued. Horses and ponies without a current valid measurement card issued by USEF will be measured by the horse show steward. Measurements will be conducted on Thursday at 3:00pm or by special arrangement.

USHJA Horse Registrations. All horses competing in federation non-breed restricted competitions must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed on-line or using the Horse Registration application form. See HU101.1 and JP100.2 of the USEF Rule Book.

HORSE/PONY HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: All animals entering the show grounds, whether competing or for schooling only, must have a current negative Coggins test dated within a year of that competition and current veterinary practice paperwork noting Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus vaccination within 6 months of the competition must be available if requested. If your animal's vaccinations were not administered by a veterinarian, you must be able to provide, if asked a receipt for purchase of vaccines, signed by the owner or agent with control of the animal; name, serial # and expiration date of the vaccine and date of administration. All requested documentation must be presented to show management/secretary upon arrival at the show grounds. Back numbers will not be issued without proper documentation.

All horses and ponies on the show grounds must be entered immediately upon arrival, no matter when you begin to school or compete. Bringing a horse or pony onto the show grounds for schooling or sales and not entering that animal on an official entry blank is prohibited. No exceptions.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Entries will close the June 24, 2021. ANY ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER 5PM on CLOSING DATE WILL BE CHARGED A \$20 LATE FEE FOR LOCAL SHOW; \$50 LATE FEE FOR USEF RATED SHOW. Entry blanks will be accepted ONLY when signed by the owner or his exhibitor's agent, trainer and rider and accompanied by a check for the STABLING FEES. Be sure to include the USEF Membership Number of your trainer, rider and Owner's USEF Membership Number on the entry form. No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order. All exhibitors in Amateur sections must present their Amateur certification at the office before numbers will be released. Non-member fees will be \$45 to USEF and \$30 to USHJA. **MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO CVPFA AND MAIL TO: Chagrin Valley Farms PO Box 714 Chagrin Falls, Ohio 44022**

PRIZE MONEY DISTRIBUTION. Prize money in all hunter and regular jumper classes, unless otherwise specified, will be distributed 32%,24%, 17%, 12%, 10%, 5%.

MANAGEMENT. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries warrant. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with GR914. The Chagrin Hunter Jumper Classic and Chagrin Valley Farms, the owner, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. ****THIS WILL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW AND SHOW GROUNDS****

REFUNDS - NO STALL FEES WILL BE REFUNDED. Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered, forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from the official show veterinarian. In either case above, the entry fees will be refunded less an office processing charge of \$20.00. Office & stall fees are nonrefundable.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS. All Hunter Classes will be judged on performance and soundness. A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be given in each Hunter section that includes an under-saddle class. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded to the two horses which have acquired the most points in each Hunter, Jumper & Equitation section. Three classes must be held in order to award champions.

JUMPER ORDER. A rotating jumping order may be established for all classes over fences. Management reserves the right to draw and post an order of go. Riders or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made.

STABLING. 180 - 10 x 10 vinyl-sided stalls with door in a permanent barn. The charge will be \$150 for the week. Stabling is limited and must be reserved in advance. Please remember to bring buckets. Stalls will be available the afternoon before the show. Hay & bedding orders must be given to the show secretary by 1:00 each day for delivery the following day. Please call Linda Joseph at (440) 488-8777, to make reservations. **STALL RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE CONFIRMED UNTIL FULL PAYMENT IS RECEIVED. TACK STALLS MAY BE LIMITED.**

FOOTING AND ARENA SIZES: Hunter rings are 130' by 260' with SRS footing by Footing First. Schooling ring is a limestone/sand mixture. Jumper ring is 200' by 300' with SRS footing by Footing First. Jumper schooling is SRS footing.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE: A processing fee of \$20.00 plus collection fees will be made for any non-negotiable checks. *All riders must wear protective headgear while mounted. * All riders and attendants must be neatly and appropriately attired when entering the ring. * No alterations are to be made to stabling or other facilities by exhibitors. * No smoking is permitted in any buildings. * Prize money will be credited to your Horse Show Invoice and any amount owed paid by check and mailed within 30 days of the show's completion. * Non-showing horses stabled at the show will be charged a \$50.00 non-showing fee (Local Show \$30) * A \$35.00 Grounds Fee & a \$25.00 Office Fee will be charged to all entries. * Hay & bedding will be charged at market price plus labor cost. * Dogs must be leashed at all times. Per USEF Rule 1301.6 dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. * The area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory line that will be indicated on the course diagram and a corresponding barrier will be erected on the course. * Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. * Children must be supervised at all times. *Horses will be allowed in the show rings only at such hours announced by management.*

SHOW APPROVALS: Local Show – OPHA; KHJA; OHJA; WPA PHA. USEF National Rated Show – USEF, USHJA, OPHA; KHJA; OHJA; WPA PHA.

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. 

Low Children's Jumpers riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same competition.

High Children's Jumper riders may not cross enter into High Junior classes or any other jumper class exceeding 1.30m at the same competition with the exception of classes which do not offer prize money (including add back money) see HU141 and HU137 for cross entry restrictions.

Horse/Pony

Horse and Rider Combination:

Low Children's horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the High Children's Jumpers at the same competition.

High Children's horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Low Children's Jumpers at the same competition.

Fence Height:

- Low Children's Jumper 1.00m to 1.05m
- High Children's Jumper 1.10m to 1.15m

Combining/Dividing Sections:

Sections may be divided by age of rider and may also be combined (Children's with Adult Amateur sections) if so stated in the prize list.

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section:

- Low Children's Jumper section
- High Children's Jumper section
