RULES & REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rulebook will be judged in accordance therewith.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

USEF/USHJA CREDENTIALS AND MEASUREMENT CARDS. All participants must present to the show secretary current USEF and USHJA membership cards or copies thereof. Amateur certification, and measurement cards for Junior Hunters and Pony Hunters must be presented to the horse show secretary before numbers will be issued. Horses and ponies without a current valid measurement card issued by USEF will be measured by the horse show steward. Measurements will be conducted on Thursday at 3:00pm or by special arrangement.

USHJA Horse Registrations. All horses competing in federation non-breed restricted competitions must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA (exception: opportunity, academy, exhibition, walk-trot and lead line). A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed on-line or using the Horse Registration application form. See HU101.1 and JP100.2 of the USEF Rule Book.

MICROCHIPPING. All horses that are competing in classes which require USHJA registration which are not microchipped will be ineligible to compete in Federation licensed competitions. Exceptions: USHJA Outreach and those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9.

USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

HORSE/PONY HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: All animals entering the show grounds, whether competing or for schooling only, must have a current negative Coggins test dated within a year of that competition. Per USEF GR-845 Equine Vaccination Rule: At Federation Licensed Competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus & Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino-pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months of entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.

ENTRIES. Competitors are encouraged to submit their show entries online at <http://www.horshowsonline.com/> Mail Entries to: Chagrin Valley Farms PO Box 714 Chagrin Falls, Ohio 44022. Faxed Entries will NOT be accepted.

Entries will close June 30, 2022. ANY ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER 5PM on CLOSING DATE WILL BE CHARGED A \$20 LATE FEE FOR LOCAL SHOW; \$50 LATE FEE FOR USEF RATED SHOW. Entry blanks will be accepted ONLY when signed by the owner or his exhibitor's agent, trainer and rider and accompanied by a check or credit card for the STABLING FEES. Be sure to include the USEF/USHJA Membership Number of your trainer, rider and Owner's USEF/USHJA Membership Number on the entry form. No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order and form of payment received. All exhibitors in Amateur sections must present their Amateur certification at the office before numbers will be released. Non-member fees will be \$45 to USEF and \$30 to USHJA. **MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO CVPHA AND MAIL TO: Chagrin Valley Farms PO Box 714 Chagrin Falls, Ohio 44022** A processing fee of \$20.00 plus collection fees will be made for any non-negotiable check.

PRIZE MONEY DISTRIBUTION: Prize money in all hunter classes, unless otherwise specified, will be distributed 32%, 24%, 17%, 12%, 10%, 5%.

MANAGEMENT: Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries warrant. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with GR914.

RESPONSIBILITY: The Chagrin Hunter Jumper Classic and Chagrin Valley Farms, the owner, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. ****THIS WILL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW AND SHOW GROUNDS****

REFUNDS - NO STALL FEES WILL BE REFUNDED. Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered, forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from the official show veterinarian. In either case above, the entry fees will be refunded less an office processing charge of \$20.00. Office & stall fees are nonrefundable.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS. All Hunter Classes will be judged on performance and soundness. A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be given in each Hunter section that includes an under-saddle class. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded to the two horses which have acquired the most points in each Hunter, Jumper & Equitation section. Three classes must be held in order to award champions. All Rated Hunter sections will be combined as necessary according to current USEF rules.

JUMPER ORDER. A rotating jumping order may be established for all classes over fences. Management reserves the right to draw and post an order of go. Riders or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made.

STABLING. 180 - 10 x 10 vinyl-sided stalls with doors, dirt floor, some mats, in a permanent barn. The charge will be \$100 for the Local Show and \$150 for USEF Rated Show. Stabling is limited and must be reserved in advance. Please remember to bring buckets. Stalls will be available Wednesday July 6, 2022 after 3pm for Local Show. Must vacate stalls by 9am Monday, July 11, 2022. Stalls will be available for Rated Show Tuesday, July 12, 2022 after 3pm. Stalls must be vacated by 8am Monday, July 18, 2022. Hay & bedding orders must be given to the show secretary by 1:00 each day for delivery the following day. Please call Linda Joseph at (440) 488-8777, to make reservations. STALL RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE CONFIRMED UNTIL FULL PAYMENT IS RECEIVED. TACK STALLS MAY BE LIMITED.

FOOTING AND ARENA SIZES: Hunter rings are 130' by 260' with SRS footing by Footing First. Schooling ring is a limestone/sand mixture. Jumper ring is 200' by 300' with SRS footing by Footing First. Jumper schooling is SRS footing.

SHARPS CONTAINERS: Sharps containers will be provided in all barns. Competition Management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments per USEF rules.

SCHOOLING AND WARM-UP: ALL horses must be entered with paperwork completed/on file with show office prior to schooling. BACK #s MUST BE WORN for ticketed schooling. Additional ticketed schooling may be allowed, weather permitting in the afternoons on show days. Hacking/Handwalking in the hunter rings will be allowed up to approximately 45 min before official showtime (weather pending). No flatting in the jumper ring at any time after schooling day unless otherwise specified with management. THERE WILL BE NO SCHOOLING IN THE RINGS ON THE MORNINGS OF SHOW DAYS. Approved hard hats must be worn with chin-straps fastened whenever mounted. No poling or offset oxers will be allowed at any time.

HEAD GEAR: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. (GR801)

PLEASE TAKE NOTE: All riders and attendants must be neatly and appropriately attired when entering the ring. * No alterations are to be made to stabling or other facilities by exhibitors. * No smoking is permitted in any buildings. * Prize money will be credited to your Horse Show Invoice and any amount owed paid by check and mailed within 30 days of the show's completion. Please make sure current address and social security numbers are on file with show office * Non-showing horses stabled at the show will be charged a \$50.00 non-showing fee (Local Show \$30) * A \$35.00 Grounds Fee & a \$25.00 Office Fee will be charged to all entries. * Hay & bedding will be charged at market price plus labor cost. * Dogs must be leashed at all times. Per USEF Rule GR1301.6 dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. * The area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory line that will be indicated on the course diagram and a corresponding barrier will be erected on the course. * Children must be supervised at all times. * Horses will be allowed in the show rings only at such hours announced by management.*

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. 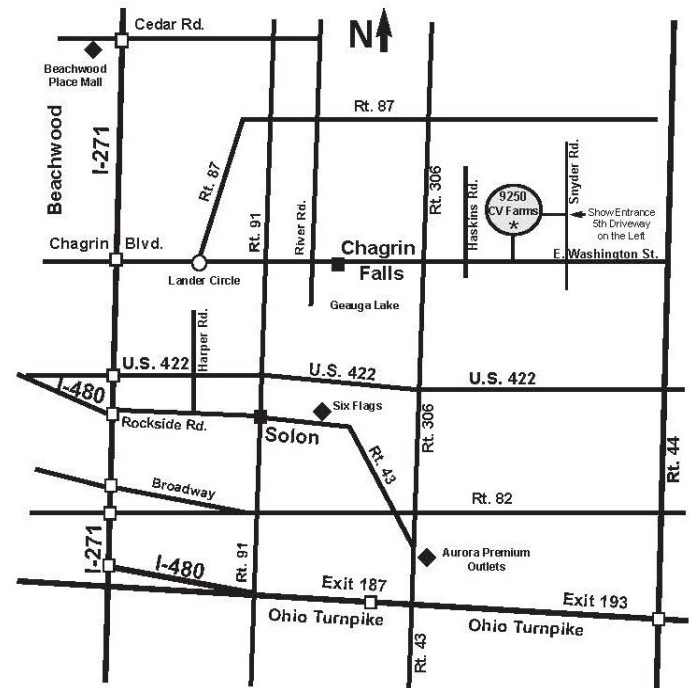

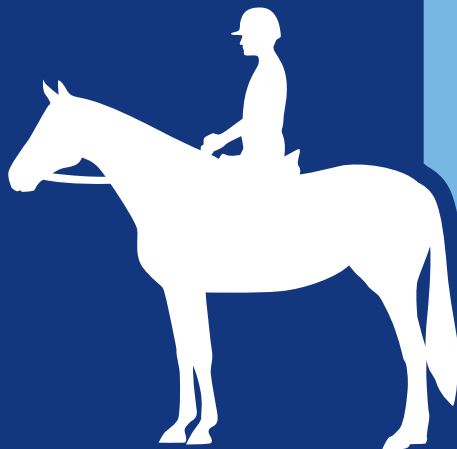

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

By signing below, I (as the participant or as the Parent/Legal Guardian of the minor identified below) hereby accept and agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement in connection with my (or the minor's) participation in any USEF Event.
